

Playroom Guidelines

Daily Hours: 9:00am - 7:30pm

- The hospital playrooms are located on the 4th, 5th and 6th floor of the hospital. If a patient is in another unit they may ask their Doctor for an order to go off the floor.
- The playroom is primarily intended for **patient use**.
 - For infection control purposes, siblings and visitors are welcome to play in the playroom if the hospital patient is present.
- Feel free to take small toys back to the patient's room for use.
- Return toys **to the dirty toy bin** located in the playroom or leave items in the patient room.
- All patients in the playroom must be supervised by an adult caregiver
- **NO food or drink** is allowed in the playroom
- **Shoes or socks** must be worn at all times
- The playroom is a "safe place" for our patients, we ask that no medical procedures or assessments are done in the playroom.
- For patients in isolation (staff wearing gowns, gloves or masks in your room) : due to safety of all patients those in isolation including both patients and siblings are not allowed in the playroom. However, staff, volunteers or an adult caregivers are welcome to take toys out of the playroom to be used in the patient rooms. Please sanitize before picking out items.

Please help your children while in the playroom be safe and respectful by modeling good behaviors such as sharing, picking up toys when finished and playing nicely with the toys and others.
